

*This hazard map shows the presumed level of flooding due to an overflow of the Kanoo River and the Kanoo River System. However, areas outside of these risk zones may experience flooding and/or the presumed level of flooding may differ in reality.
*The 1982 Nagasaki Heavy Flooding (flooded area) shown on the map is based on the Disaster History Map (flood areas caused by heavy rain and precipitation in July 1982) of the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism, and revised with reference to the Nagasaki Torrential Rain Disaster Map of October 1982.
*This hazard map displays the location of "Safety Evacuation Shelters (buildings) and Areas (spaces)" to which you can go in the event of the most severe rainfall.
