Miyazaki River Flood Hazard Map

This hazard map shows the presumed "Level of Flooding" and the location of "Safety Evacuation." Shelters" in the event that Miyazaki River floods from the expected maximum amount of rainfall. Nagasaki City's terrain makes it is easy for buildings to suffer damage during heavy local downpours. It is important to know beforehand which areas are risk areas and how to safely evacuate from them.



The dam warning station will blow a siren if there is a risk of rising river water due to dam releases. When the alarm sounds, immediately step away from the river and evacuate to a safe place.




If flooding happens, first take action to protect your life!
